

PAPER INITIAL APPLICATION FORMS



Filed and Served Initial Application Form for NSRT Compensation Order will be posted by the NSRT on its website for public viewing (RPP 3.3.4) #209



EXPERT WITNESSES

Persons giving evidence who as a result of their special skills, training or expertise may be able to assist the NSRT with respect to a scientific/technical issue relevant to the matter being considered by the NSRT (RPP 6.11) #312

NOTICE OF EXPERT WITNESSES

A Party wishing to include within its submission to the NSRT a presentation by an Expert Witness must so indicate its intention in the List of Witnesses (RPP Schedule A.4) including the witness's area(s) of expertise and a curriculum vitae/resume (RPP 6.11.1) #313

QUALIFICATION OF EXPERT WITNESSES

A Party wishing to include within its submission to the NSRT a presentation by an Expert Witness must have that witness 'qualified' as an Expert Witness by the NSRT (RPP 6.11.2) #314

TRADITIONAL KNOWLEDGE INUIT QAUJIMAJATUQANGIT WITNESSES (TKIIQ)

Persons giving evidence who possess a body of knowledge and/or unique cultural insights of Inuit into the workings of nature, humans and animals may be able to assist the NSRT with respect to an issue relevant to the matter being considered by the NSRT (RPP 6.12) #315

NOTICE OF TKIIQ WITNESSES

A party wishing to include within its submission to the NSRT a presentation by a TKIIQ witness must so indicate its intention in the list of witnesses (RPP Schedule A.4) including the area in which the TKIIQ witness will give evidence (6.12.1) #316

QUALIFICATION OF TKIIQ WITNESSES

A Party seeking to include within its submission to the NSRT a presentation by a TKHQ witness should be able to demonstrate to the NSRT that the TKHQ Witness possesses knowledge and/or unique cultural insights of Inuit into the workings of nature, humans, and animals such as to be able to assist the NSRT with respect to an issue relevant to the matter being considered by the NSRT (RPP 6.12.2) #317

QUESTIONING OF TK/IQ WITNESSES

TK IQ witnesses may only be questioned by the NSRT

Panel (RPP 6.13.3.2) #321

QUESTIONING OF CONVENTIONAL WITNESSES

- Conventional Witnesses may be questioned by the NSRT and the other Parties (RPP 6.13.3.2)
- Questioning of Conventional
 Witnesses should be conducted for the purpose of clarifying and testing the evidence provided by Conventional Witnesses, and for eliciting relevant material and information not brought out during the initial giving of evidence (RPP 6.13.3.1)
- Questioning of Conventional Witnesses must be with respect to matters which are relevant to the matter before the NSRT (RPP 6.13.3.3(a))
- Questioning of Conventional Witnesses shall not be conducted in a manner which is abusive, offensive or discourteous (RPP 6.13.3.3(b))

QUESTIONING OF EXPERT WITNESSES

- Expert Witnesses may be questioned by the NSRT and the other Parties (RPP 6.13.3.2)
- Questioning of Expert Witnesses should be conducted for the purpose of clarifying and testing the evidence provided by Expert Witnesses, and for eliciting relevant material and information not brought out during the initial giving of evidence (RPP 6.13.3.1)
- Questioning of Expert Witnesses must be with respect to matters which are relevant to the matter before the NSRT (RPP 6.13.3.3(a))
- Questioning of Expert Witnesses shall not be conducted in a manner which is abusive, offensive or discourteous (RPP 6.13.3.3(b))
